I am excited to announce that **fourth**, **fifth and sixth graders at** Jenkintown Elementary School will be participating in the Montgomery County Intermediate Unit's **Reading Olympics!** This has been a tremendously successful program that encourages children to read. Last year over 1,000 students participated from 21 school districts! Students from all over the county will work in groups to read 25 books from the Reading Olympics list. Teams will compete to answer comprehension questions about the books.

This year, beginning in December, teams will meet on a weekly basis during lunch/recess. Students will work with coaches to tackle the book list, discuss books and prepare for the big event that will be held in the spring.
